Yamunotri is only 13 km. from Hanuman Chatti, But it is better to proceed another 6 km. and have the night halt at Janakibai Chatti. The journey to Yamunotri is simply breathtaking. High snow-covered peaks all around, glaciers, streams and waterfalls, vibrant green foliage, and the pristine air are a sheer delight to tired city lungs. Yamunotri, 3322 meters above sea level, is located on the western bank of the great peak of Bandarpunch (meaning – monkey’s tail) which is 6315 meters high.
